

Academic Integrity Policy Committee

Composition: 11

9 Faculty, one chosen from each of the Senate divisions

1 AVP of Academic Administration and Outreach or designee (ex officio, non-voting)

1 Director of Student Conduct and Community Standards or designee (ex officio, non-voting)

Selection: Members are nominated by the Rules Committee to be confirmed by the Senate.

Charges:

1. Periodically review and propose appropriate revisions to the Academic Integrity Policy and Handbook to Faculty Senate.
2. Interpret AI policy and handbook for clarification upon request from faculty, Academic Integrity Committee, or SCCS.
3. Collaborate with SCCS about training Academic Integrity Committee members related to interpretation of the policy.
4. Review annual outcome data collected by SCCS.
 - a. Report the percentage of overturned cases and the common reasons, and potential systemic problems to the Senate.
5. Review outcomes for disparate impact and make recommendations to reduce bias.
6. Ensure adequate reporting-faculty opportunities to participate in the appeals process.
