Criteria for the Annual KansasBoard of RegentsFaculty of the Year Award

Nominees

Eligibility is restricted to faculty meeting the following requirements:

- x Full-time, tenured or tenurer faculty
- x Demonstrate one's teaching, scholars here each, and service over the preceding academic yearhave exemplified excellence and commitment to the mission of the institution (confirmed by the dean of their respective college
- x Have not received the annual KBOPE culty of the Year Award in the previous two (2) years.

Nominations

Nominations must adhere to the following guidelines to be accepted:

- x Nominations may only be submitted by a faculty natoremployed at the same institution as the nominee during the peding academic year.
- x A faculty senatomay submit two ominations per year, one for a tenured faculty and one for a tenure faculty.

<u>Submission</u>

- x Nominations must be submitted to the culty Senate KBOR Faculty of the Year AwardsCommittee" See first bullet under Selection
- x Nominations are due by Marchth **5**f the avarding year[#]
- x Nomination includes nomineersame, academic department distribution of their workload for the academic year in which they are being nominated.
- x Nominaton includes the nominator's name, academic department their institution
- x A summary not to exceed 500 word the nominee's accomplishments including evidence to support the nomination.

Suggested examples of supporting materials/evidence:

<u>Selection</u>

- x The Faculty Senate at each institution shall have a committee consistingeoft fulltime faculty (including the Faculty Senate President asferio member) to collect and review the applications for the KBORacultyof the YearAwards(KBOR Award Committee) This committee will verify with the can of the respective college that the nominee is in good standing with the university and their academic departmeetite nominee's teaching, scholarship/research, and service over the preceding academic year have exemplified excellence and commitment to the invisof the institution, and verify the nomination is valid and complete complete nominations or lack of a dean's validation will not be considered will be at the discretion of each university KBOR Award Committee on how the final selection will be made.
- x Any acting KBOR Award Committee members will recuse themselves (excluding the Faculty Senate President) from the review and selection process if they have been nominated for the award he Faculty Senate President will appoint a replacement to serve on the KBOR Award Committee.

KansasBoard of Regents(KBOR)

- x The namesof the two awardrecipients determined by each university's KBOR Award Committee (one tenure of aculty and one tenure track faculty) will be provided to the Chair of the Counselof Faculty Senate Presiden (SOFSP) The Chair of the COFSP will submit the namesof all award recipients to the Kansas Board of Regents by May 15th of the awarding year
- x The Kansas Board of Regents will review and approve/reject he award recipients provided by the Chair of the COFSP during the annual KBOR August retreat.
- x Faculty receiving awards will be notified prior to the Septembe KBOR meeting (typically Wednesda of the 3rd week of September)
- x Awardees are highly recommended to attenedSeptember(BOR meeting to be recognized for their achievement.
