











- Council of Independent Colleges Tuition Exchange Program (CIC -TEP):
 - f Tuition-free enrollment across 440+ institutions.
 - f CIC-TEP demonstrates how institutions can collaborate to provide expansive educational opportunities for their employees.
- 2. University of Missouri System:
 - f 75% tuition waiver for courses across campuses.
 - f This system-wide benefit facilitates professional development and education for employees without being limited to their home institution.
- 3. Big Ten Academic Alliance:
 - f Scholarship programs for cross -campus enrollment.
 - f Example: the University of Nebraska- Lincoln offers an Employee Scholarship Program, allowing employees to take courses at other campuses in the alliance under specific conditions.

- 4. University of Kansas Third Party Tuition Assistance
 - f Allows employees to receive tuition assistance for courses at third party institutions
 - f Contingent upon course completion and submission of required documentation
 - f Reimbursement program
 - f Demonstrates an existing effective framework for ensuring accountability and facilitating professional growth
 - f Beyond the employing campus borders
