WSU Admission Requirements If you are a transfer student with 24 credit hours or more, you must: Have a minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA (on a 4.00 scale) on all previous college work. If you are a transfer student under age 21, with fewer than 24 credit hours, you must: Have a minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA (on a 4.00 scale on all previous college work and meet the freshman requirements. WSU Transfer Credit Acceptance It is the policy of WSU to accept all credits – with the exception of remedial coursework – earned at a postsecondary institution accredited by one of the U.S. regional accrediting agencies.
