Taylor was born with arthrogryposis, a congenital disease that restricts muscular development and affects joints in the body. He uses a motorized wheelchair for mobility. Even though he would be described by many as having a severe disability, Taylor is a professional tennis player in the quad division. At the Paralympics, he has won three gold medals, one silver medal in doubles competition and one bronze medal in the singles division, making him one of the most decorated Paralympians ever. Additionally, Taylor won over 100 tournament titles, four U.S. Open doubles titles, and 14 straight World Cup Team championships.

For seven years, Taylor volunteered as director of operations for the Paralympic Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.
