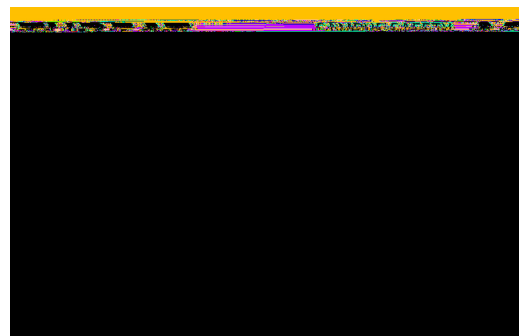
Campus Safety:

Providing a safe and secure environment for the WSU community continues to be a top priority.

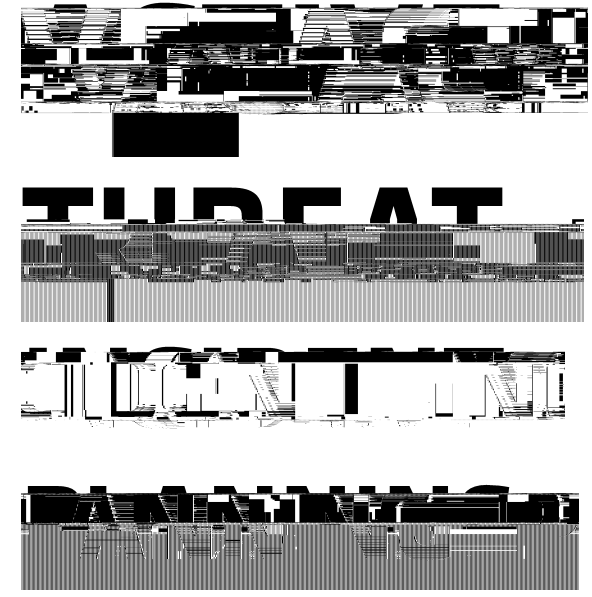

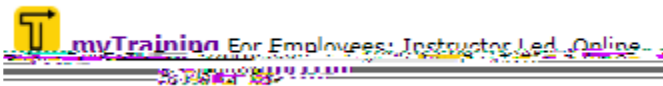

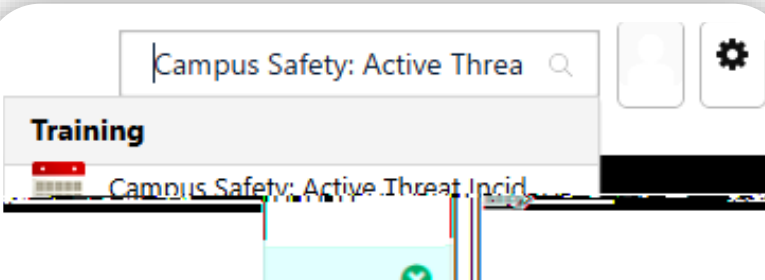
